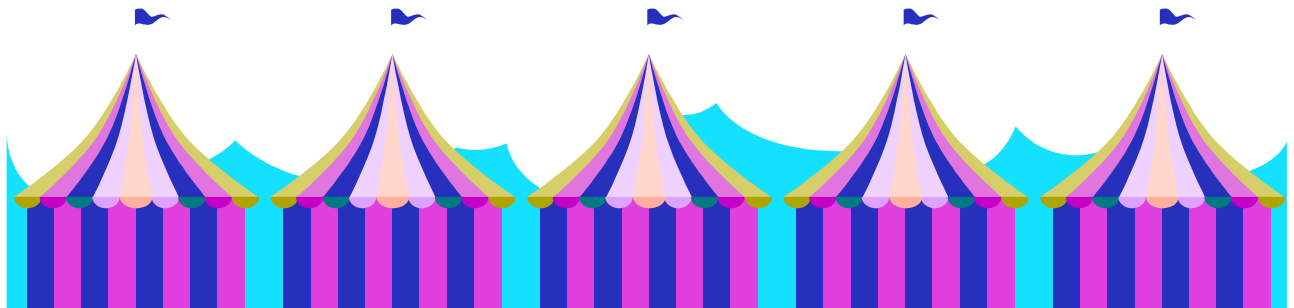

Jubilee Tea Dance Tuesday 5th June 3pm – 6pm at Gill Nethercott Centre, Whitchurch

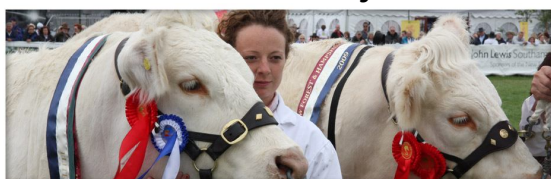
Celebrate the Queen's Diamond Jubilee in true 50's style...
